Call Forwarding



Allows you to transfer all your incoming calls to another number. A great feature for the business person who wants to take calls after-hours or for anyone who doesn't want to miss an important call when they are away from home.

To activate Call Forwarding

- Listen for dial tone and press *72 (or dial 1172 on a rotary phone).
- Wait for dial tone, then dial the number that will be accepting your calls. Once the called party answers, Call Forwarding is in effect.
- If the line is busy or no one answers, hang up and repeat the first two steps. You will hear three short beeps indicating that Call Forwarding is active.
- While Call Forwarding is active, your telephone will ring briefly each time your number is dialed. You cannot
 answer the call, but the ring serves as a reminder that Call Forwarding is active. You can continue to make
 calls.
- NOTE: If there are charges associated with the number to which you are having your calls sent, you will be billed for each call forwarded from your phone.

To cancel Call Forwarding

- Listen for dial tone and press *73 (or dial 1173 on a rotary phone).
- Three short beeps will confirm cancellation.
