

Telemarketing Do Not Call Registry



Federal

1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236) - call from the number you wish to register or on the web go to <https://www.donotcall.gov> - you must have active email address to register via the internet. This registration will not expire. Most telemarketers should not call your number once it has been on the registry for 31 days. If they do, you can file a complaint at this Website. Registration is free.

Wisconsin uses the National Do Not Call list for registrations. To verify that your number is registered, check through the [federal website](#) or call 1-888-382-1222 (TTY: 1-866-290-4236). You must call from the phone you want to verify.

Wisconsin residents who sign up for the National Do Not Call Registry are protected by both the federal Do Not Call law and by Wisconsin's telemarketing laws

If you receive telemarketing calls after you have registered your telephone number and it has been in the registry for three months, you can file a complaint at donocall.gov or by calling 1-888-382-1222. You will have to know the company's name or phone number to file a complaint.

PLEASE NOTE: Calls from or on behalf of political organizations, charities, and telephone surveyors are exempt, as are calls from companies with which you have an existing business relationship or those to whom you've provided express agreement in writing to receive their calls. Even if a call is exempt from this law, you can still stop many of these calls just by telling them not to call you again. Federal law requires every business to place your name on their "no call" list if you request it. You should keep a record of the date you make the request.
